RECYCLING MADE SIMPLE!



General Rules:

- Most recyclable containers (plastic, glass or metal) are used in the kitchen or bathroom (food, beverage or soap containers).
 - Recycle bottles with caps on.
 - Remove and dispose of spray and pump tops, recycle the bottles.
- Paper may be anywhere in your living space. If you can rip it, you can recycle it.
- Cardboard should be empty and flattened.

5 Don'ts

Do not include things that are:

- STRINGY or STRETCHY** (plastic bags, cords)
- SHARP** (needles, knives, screws, razor blades)
- SPARKY** (batteries, items containing batteries)
- SMALL** (nothing smaller than your fist)
- SMELLY** (nothing with food or liquid on it)

WHEN IN DOUBT, THROW IT OUT!

REMEMBER:

- No food or liquid – everything is empty, clean, and dry.
- Items should be loose in your cart (not in plastic bags).
